

## **POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

### **PREPARATION**

1. Suggested poster size is A0 — 84.1cm wide (33.1 inches) x 118.9cm (46.8 inches) tall (portrait orientation). [The poster boards are 90 cm wide by 210 cm tall, which is slightly smaller than A0 plus.]
2. Font and figures should be large enough to be clearly visible from a distance of approximately 1m (3ft 2in) or more.
3. At the top of each poster, you must clearly list the title, the names of the authors and their affiliations.
4. There are no other requirements or restrictions on specific layouts, scheme, font, colors, figures.
5. You may include QR codes linking to further data relating to your poster or to your researcher's page, on your poster.
6. You may also add a portrait photo of yourself to help the audience recognize you more easily.

### **POSTER DISPLAY**

7. Please place your poster on the board with your assigned poster number on July 8th.
8. We will provide pins and paper for your poster number. Please attach the poster number paper to the top of your poster.
9. Poster presentation times are as follows:  
July 8<sup>th</sup>: 16:30 – 17:15 for odd number 17:15 – 18:00 for even number  
July 10<sup>th</sup>: 16:35 – 17:15 for odd number. 17:15 – 18:00 for even number

### **POSTER WITHDRAWAL**

10. You must remove your poster by 16:30 on Friday, July 11th.
11. Any posters that are not removed by the above deadlines will be taken down and must be claimed from the reception desk.
